IN YOUR HOME

- **Move possessions to a higher level**
- **Protect doorways and air-vents with sandbags or flood-boards**
- **Monitor TV weather reports**
- **If your home is flooded turn off gas, electricity and water supplies**
- **Move upstairs if possible**
- **If trapped in deep flooding, stay by a window and call for help**
- **Throw away food that has been in contact with flood water**
- **When water recedes don't switch gas, electricity, water back on until systems are inspected**
