## **Planning and Preparing for an Emergency**

Take advantage of all the information that is available, both online or via the media, download it, print it – in case there is a power cut - and keep the information in a safe place. At the beginning of autumn (or when you are aware of a potential emergency developing) review the information to confirm you have the up-to-date information.
