Time of collection

Please place your waste out the night before, as collections start earlier than normal

Christmas Trees

If you're part of the garden waste collection scheme, please cut up your real tree and place it in your brown wheelie-bin or compostable sacks and put out as normal

Wet paper and cardboard

Cannot be recycled. Either put them in the bottom of your box, stack your boxes, keep them undercover, cover with a blue bag, or save them for a non-rainy day

Garden waste

Collections will coincide with the above schedule

Christmas cards

Many charities collect these for fundraising. Put cards made from paper into your black recycling box

Wrapping paper

Put this in your recycling box. Metallic paper must be put in your blue bag
