



- We have reviewed and commented on all 44 sites put forward for Finchampstead






Gorse Ride Regeneration



- Represented on the Steering Group
- Phase 1 Cockayne Court and part of Arnett Avenue
 46 new flats and houses to be completed late 2020
- Phase 2 plans for 248 flats, houses and bungalows. Planning application expected soon.

Arborfield Strategic Development Location





- Homes occupied to date at Arborfield Green include around 150 in Finchampstead
 - Work has started on Finchwood Park – all within Finchampstead Parish. First homes occupied December 2019


Cemex Restoration






 We contributed to boardwalks for the new 'Ridges Ramble' at Finchampstead Ridges

- Delivering value for money




