Dear resident,

We are writing to inform you of upcoming overnight road closures in your area. These will take place between 8pm and 6am on weeknights between 14 September and 15 October.

This relates to the area around California Crossroads including on Finchampstead Road, Nine Mile Ride and Windsor Ride. This is to allow us to carry our preparatory surveys and obtain information about the ground conditions to help avoid disruption during the construction work in this area.

Works phases

Work will be carried out in phases at each location with a road closure in place unless otherwise stated. Signed diversions will be in place at each location to assist road users. The route for these are outlined below.

Phase one – 14 to 18 September

- Location – Finchampstead Road, Windsor Ride to Nine Mile Ride
- Diversion via Nine Mile Ride, A321 Sandhurst Road and Finchampstead Road

Phase two – 21 to 25 September

- Location – Nine Mile Ride, Finchampstead Road to Kiln Ride
- Diversion via Nine Mile Ride, A321 Sandhurst Road and Finchampstead Road

Phase three – 28 September to 2 October

- Location – Nine Mile Ride, Finchampstead Road to Manor Park Drive
- Diversion via Finchampstead Road, Jubilee Road, The Village, A327 Eversley Road, Langley Common Road, Biggs Lane, Park Lane and Nine Mile Ride

Phase four – 5 to 9 October

- Extents – Finchampstead Road, Nine Mile Ride to Warren Lane
- Diversion via Jubilee Road, The Village, Fleet Hill, A327 Reading Road, A327 Eversley Road, Langley Common Road, Biggs Lane, Park Lane and Nine Mile Ride

Phase five – 12 to 15 October

- Note this will be multi-way temporary traffic lights rather than a road closure
- Extents – Windsor Ride, Finchampstead Road to Summit Close
- Diversion – Finchampstead Road, Pine Drive

The works will include a CCTV survey of the drainage network, core samples taken from the road and a radar survey to locate all the underground services.

Please note vehicle access or exit to properties may be restricted or delayed during these works. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Please refrain from parking or leaving any obstruction on the carriageway on the day(s) of the proposed works.
