211/2022 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

213/2022 CURRENT PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The Committee considered 22 planning applications as detailed in Appendix A.

- 12 Chivers Drive: TPO-730-1995 (222716)
 - T2 Oak Tree Carry out crown thinning (20-25%)
 - T1 Silver Birch Formative trim maintaining symmetry and reducing length of right lower limb.
- 12 Tomlinson Drive: TPO 361/1988 (222737)
 - G1, Oak Crown thinning 15%, reduction of north west side by 2-3m away from house roof. Remove epicormic growth up to main branches to maintain current position.
 - T6, Oak Selective pruning for crown reduction back to previous pruning point and remove epicormic growth up to main branches to maintain current position.
 - T7, Oak Crown thinning 15%, reduction of south west side to maximum allowance away from neighbours roof, and remove epicormic growth up to main branches to maintain current position.
- 8 Hazelbank: TPO-635-1993 (222746)
 - T1, Oak tree (T1 on TPO) Tip reduce the canopy on the south side and crown thin, to reduce encroachment on the house and to maintain the tree in good health.
- Land At Hogwood Garden Village and North East of The Stables, Adjacent to Nine Mile Ride Extension (222849)
 - TPO 1444/2012 A1, 1454/2012 T3 and 1609/2017 W1 W5, Mixed Species.
 - Reduce all trees within the 10m wide corridor located below temporary overhead line. Crown reductions will reduce tree heights from 15m to 12.5m for all trees in the corridor.
 - T8, Oak (T3 on TPO) Reduce the tree height from 16m to 13.5m and the cardinal points of the crown reduced back by no more than 2m.
 - G45, Mixed Species (TPO 1609/2017 W1) Fell Ash trees and dead standing and reduce the height of the remaining trees situated below the temporary overhead lines.
 - This was considered by The Parish's TPO sub-committee due to the felling involved and no objections were raised.

- Deers Leap, Hollybush Ride: TPO 1891/2022, GROUP 1 (222557)
 - T1, Pine (part of G1) Fell.
 - TPO 1891/2022 has subsequently been served on 2 groups of trees at this location including this pine.
- Land on verge to the north of Moor Farm and south of Little Moor, Park Lane, TPO 1839/2022, W1 (223031)
 - T1, T2, T5, T6, T7, T15, T16, T17, T20, T21 & T23 Fell 11 x Alders and replace T11, T12, T13 Remove and replant 3 x stumps
 - This was considered by The Parish's TPO sub-committee due to the felling involved and the following comments have been submitted to The Borough:

 The Council is not sure a one-for-one replacement with whips is satisfactory and would prefer to see a replanting with more mature trees and perhaps a mix of species.
