Gorse Ride regeneration

- Work window 9am to 5:30pm, Monday to Friday.
- The Swale will be constructed by vibrating large sheets of metal into the ground. This
 process does produce noise.

• The park is closed again for the final stage of repairs.

PLANNING COMMITTEE

- The Committee met on Wed 18 October at the FBC Centre. The minutes have been circulated.
- 10 applications were considered. 3 were objected to. Previous comments made in relation to the Arborfield District Centre/Parcel O2 and 31 Barkham Ride were updated and reinforced on revised plans.
- 12 WBC decisions were noted and all but 3 were in line with our comments.

- Proposals for the Arborfield District centre (230872) was approved at WBC Planning on 11 October. Updates have been circulated from both the Developer & WBC regarding plans & timescales for enabling works.
- Cllr Grainger kindly wrote a response to the WBC consultation, on their Statement of Community Involvement, which was submitted on behalf of the Parish Council.
- The FNDP team will be closing, and the Planning Committee will revisit the Plan in 6 months' time in relation to the Local Plan Update.

RIGHTS OF WAY COMMITTEE

- There has not been a meeting.
- Cemex has been constructing a new bridleway at Manor Farm in accordance with the original planning permission. Works are expected to be complete by summer 2024.

ROADS & ROAD SAFETY COMMITTEE

Cllr Bromley reported on current matters.

- No roads meeting has taken place.
- Speed watch sessions continue and are averaging exactly 20 vehicles per session. A recess is being planned in December and January.
- Looking for new Speed Watch volunteers.
- Traffic monitoring has not yet resumed after the summer holidays. The problem with one of the units not logging vehicles has not yet been resolved.
- Building works at the crossroads has reduced the number of available parking spaces at the Avery corner car park.
- California Crossroads improvement scheme Initial surveys will be completed this week
 and results reviewed which will identify and address any potential major concerns or
 challenges before construction work commences in February/ March 2024. WBC are
 continuing work on the traffic management plans and are aiming to meet with the
 affected businesses around the end of November to update them on the progress of the
 works.
